

INTERNATIONAL VIDEO PRESELECTION

We are pleased to announce the **new video submission option** to apply for a **Golden Pass** to Grand Prix Dance Open America 2026. Participants may now **submit a performance video** to be reviewed directly by the **Board of Directors**, with the opportunity to receive a **Golden Pass** granting direct access to the Grand Prix Finals in Fort Lauderdale, FL.

Those who prefer to compete in live regional events will still have that option. This new format is designed to provide a more flexible and accessible experience for all dancers and studios.

Below you will find the **full instruction document** with all details on how to submit your video, requirements, deadlines, and fees.

Finals Location: Fort Lauderdale, Florida, USA. April 22 to 26, 2026

Eligibility: Open to individuals and ensembles of all nationalities who comply with Grand Prix Dance Open America rules and regulations.

Video Preselection for Golden Pass

Dancers may submit a **video for review by the Board of Directors** to be considered for a **Golden Pass** to the Finals.

Videos will be evaluated based on talent, technique, execution, musicality, and artistry.

Videos may be submitted **at any time** via **email** (<u>danceopenamerica@gmail.com</u>). Video submission deadline is March 1st, 2026.

Soloist Application Fee: \$100 USD flat fee (not refundable) you can submit up to 2 videos, don't need to be the same for the Finals. Payment and registration must be completed to be officially considered for the Golden Pass.

Pas de Deux, Duos/Trios and Ensembles Application Fee: \$100 USD flat fee (not refundable) per piece, don't need to be the same for the Finals.



Video Requirements:

- The videos sent should include the following information: Participant/s name/s, age, School/Instructor Name, and Work Titles.
- Dress Code: We encourage participants to wear the appropriate costume for the represented piece; however, if not possible, please wear a color that will clearly contrast with your background. For ladies, pink tights, and a leotard, for men, black or gray tights with a white T-shirt for men will be permitted (we will not accept any videos of a participant wearing warm-up clothing or leggings)
- By taking part in this competition, you (the competitor) waive all performance rights in case of television broadcasting and/or any recording during the competition.
- DOA reserves the right to use any photo or video recording of participants' performances during the contest for further promotional purposes.
- DOA does not pay royalties.
- Competitors must ensure that they have the right to perform both classical and contemporary works.
- Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed.
- All submissions will be evaluated for Golden Pass eligibility.
- Participants may also register for Regional Semifinals, where they will be automatically evaluated for Finals placement.
- Deadline for submitting your videos is March 1st, 2026

Divisions:

Classical and Contemporary Solos:

Rising: Age 8 to 10 years

Junior: Age 11 to 13 years

Teen: Age 14 to 16 years

Senior: Age 17 to 19 years

Professional: Age 20 to 24 years

All other categories:

(Duos/Trios Contemporary, Classical Pas de Deux, Ensembles: over 4 participants)

Intermediate: Age 8 to 13 years

Advanced: Age 14 to 24 years

The category will depend on the result of the group age average. This will be divided among only two categories, as labeled above: Intermediate/Advanced
